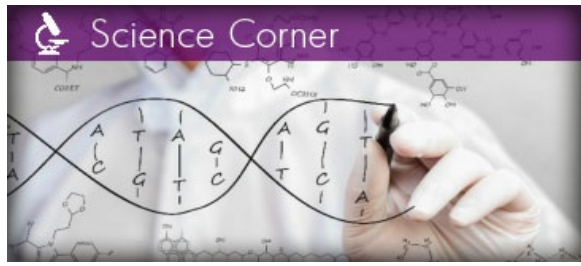

## Egg Numbers per Donor and Egg Quality

The World Egg Bank's focus is on recipient outcome. Yes, we could do things differently to provide less expensive eggs but we feel that when parents are considering an undertaking with so much on the line,

quality must not be sacrificed for convenience.

We are often asked if our donors are aggressively stimulated. It is true that by getting more eggs one could provide less expensive eggs, but many endocrinologists and embryologists worry that by over stimulating the donor a poorer quality of egg would be produced. To a certain extent this may be true. Because the data necessary to determine this largely has been collected from general IVF cases, and not from donor egg cycles only, The World Egg Bank has chosen to err on the side of conservative stimulations. However, we can learn much by looking at data from non-donor IVF cases.

The World Egg Bank protocols results in an average of 20 ova per donor. All the evidence that the production of large numbers of eggs might result in a poorer outcome comes from non-donor IVF patients where the eggs are being placed back into the patient's uterus during a stimulation, where estrogen and progesterone levels are very high. There is good evidence that pregnancy rates can be impaired mainly due to the eggs being placed into this hormone charged environment, and so many clinics now freeze all embryos for transfer into a frozen cycle with a more natural uterine environment.

One researcher (Sunkara et al, 2011) looked at live birth rates as they related to the number of eggs retrieved. The chart below shows that live birth rates did not suffer until more than 25 eggs were retrieved. Even so, this slight decrease in pregnancy rate could be due to a hormone charged endometrium, which is not an issue in egg donation.
