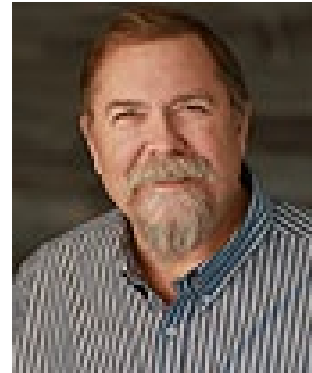

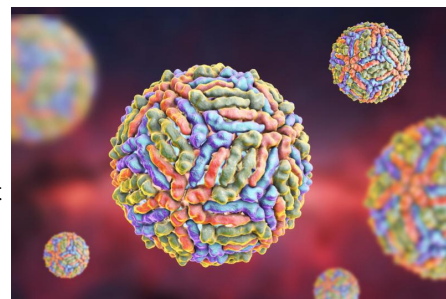


## New FDA Guidelines: West Nile Virus

West Nile Virus (WNV) is an arbovirus spread principally by Culex mosquitos that occur widely in the continental US. Mosquitos pick up the virus from infected birds and transmit it to other birds, mainly in the summer.

After being bitten by an infected mosquito, most people with West Nile Virus are asymptomatic or mildly symptomatic with a flu-like illness with or without a rash (West Nile fever). However, encephalitis (WNE) or meningitis (WNM) may follow infection, with significant morbidity and mortality rates. [Read more](#)
